





Fly Folds... and Unfolds!

It does what?

It's true — Fly folds into less than half its volume, for compact storage and shipping.

And Fly is LIGHT - less than 1/4 of the weight of a standard Tempest Typhoon rental enclosure.

Take a look...

The Fly chassis folds flat, for super-compact shipping and storage



flip up the front and back, lock with captive stainless steel pins (no tools)

The Fly tray takes any projector up to the maximum for your Fly model, and snaps securely into the chassis (still no tools)



The Fly Cover pins into place in seconds (right, no tools)

The doors latch either side, without (you guessed it) tools...





Now, just add your favorite rigging accessories.

This one has simple feet.



Fly is Landscape...



Fly 35, with Truss Hanger Kit clamps securely to trusses up to 24in/62cm wide

Flexible Fly

Fly is so easy to reconfigure. Landscape now, portrait later, and with any projector in your rental fleet, up to the maximum for your Fly model.

The projector bolts to Fly's projector tray, which locks in place securely for operation in any orientation.

Same enclosure, same truss hangers, flipped to portrait mode. It only takes a minute (but you do need a

This Fly 35 Tray comes with mounting holes for the Panasonic RQ35 pictured here, and many smaller projectors.


Need more? Just drill new mounting holes.

The lightweight nylon fan cowl inflates when the projector is running to protect the insect screen and connector panel against rain.

It's easily rotated 90° for portrait operation — no tools!

Fly gives you Options

Air Quality — Standard

Fly comes as standard with Tempest's well-proven MERV11 filter, for dust and mild salt air, cracked oil, or other airborne pollutants.


Air Quality — Extreme

Now, Tempest offers a medicalgrade True HEPA filter with active carbon pre-filter, for the ultimate in projector air quality. The HEPA option requires a more powerful centrifugal fan, which adds slightly to the enclosure weight and cost. Use it in areas of high salinity or with high concentrations of other pollutants.

Positive Pressure Option

In either case, the Fly Positive Pressure option keeps air flowing through the enclosure at low speed when the projector is in standby mode, preventing pollutants from entering through the exhaust insect screen.

Tempest filters are as large as they can be, for better airflow at lower air velocity. That means more efficient removal of impurities and very long filter life.

Fly's AR-coated port glass door opens without tools, allowing quick and easy lens changing, even at the top of a ladder!

Long Lenses?

A deeper Lens Extender door assembly is available for extralong lenses.



Fly Rigging Frame

Fly is not just an enclosure, it's a **SYSTEM**.

The Fly Rigging Frame is strong and incredibly light — one person can carry it, and two can rig it in under five minutes with just a screw gun.

For large outdoor events, stack three Fly enclosures, landscape or portrait, cable and test them at ground level.

Set your desired enclosure angle - shooting up to 45° up or down, then crane them up to the top of a building in one go.











This Fly Rigging Frame is on its way to high places — three Fly 50 enclosures, portrait mode, with three Griffyn 50ks, prepped on the ground, ready to plug and play..



Set the front level bar in the indexed location for the desired enclosure angle (approx. 4° increments)

Slide the enclosure into position and secure with the Fly safety lock on both

Check for level on the T-levels in the frame base.







Remote Monitoring

Tempest System Manager is a Windows app running on a local PC connected to your enclosures over a local area network.

TSM discovers any Tempest enclosures present on the network at initialization, and monitors system attributes in real time, including lamp, fan and heater status, temperature, relative humidity and more.

TSM may also be used to upload firmware updates to enclosure controllers over the network, without having to visit each enclosure




